Docks Report

Not much to report but here goes!

1. Gyn Pole Crane was taken down and inspected/maintained on April 22nd 2023 no issues were found and inspection report was filed in the Docks Binder
2. Launch was successfully completed April 29th 2023 – Moir Crane was present with 2 cranes and launch was completed by noon or so.

After a suggestion by a member of the club I am acting on a new idea – that of putting a sealed cabinet out at the Gyn Pole Dock to store the Gyn Pole Crane drill and associated gear as the number of miles we put on the cart hauling this stuff back and forth to the shed is getting high. Should not cost more than a few hundred dollars.
7. I am working on getting a quote to replace all the 120V receptacles at the docks and their weather tight covers...
