There will likely be only 2 Adult Sailing courses offered in 2024, plus 2 SKS classes.

Planning for 2024

The executive needs to develop policies and procedures for use of the club boats by LTS graduates. This could be a good retention strategy for our LTS graduates/social members.

I will contact Adult Sailing grads from the last few years to see how much interest there is in a Boat Share program and report back the findings in January.

I will propose the following for our Boat Share program:

- 1- Participants must be full members
- 2- Participants will have the Basic Cruising certification or demonstrate equivalent sailing experience.
- 3- The boat will be maintained by the participants who will receive work hours for maintenance
- 4- Participants will pay \$350 for the season for boat use
- 5- We will cap the number of participants to 4 for the use of Tenacious
- 6- Tenacious will be available for Adult Sailing use as a back-up boat and for use if there are concurrent courses running.
