### **Cradle Day & Haul Out 2023 Information You Should Know**

**[HAUL-OUT – Starts at 8:00 am sharp Sat. Oct 21st](#)**

- 1) Cradle Day is the 14th - Mike will have the layout done for Monday the 9th and it will be posted inside the clubhouse on the bulletin board!
- 2) Members with accounts in arrears may not haul out.
- 3) We will have two cranes this year. One for the back and another for the front parking lot.
- 4) Ensure you are there on time if you are the 1st few to be lifted.
- 5) Vessels on trailers not being stored at the club will be hauled out 1st and are to be removed immediately from the parking lot
- 6) **No parking on the grounds until after cranes have left. Please be very careful where you park on the street. Parking on the bike paths is **not** allowed. Good Luck!**
- 7) To optimize efficiency & save crane time:
  - Ensure 'Tag Lines' at bow & stern are long enough for a 20' lift
  - Make sure your motor runs, prior to moving to lift position
  - Lift Points are to be marked along rail for lift crew to properly locate Lift Slings. They must also be able to be readable from the top side of the deck.
  - Be ready in Queue when it's your turn to be lifted
  - **Ensure your cradle Pads are in the correct location**
  - **If the crane crew feels that you are not prepared properly, you MAY be changed for extra time.**
- 8) In consideration of Lift Crews, there is no power washing of hulls, until they are fully clear of spray.
- 9) Provide assistance to New Members as needed
