

Annual Meeting Report Youth Sail

Youth Sail again had a record breaking year in that it graduated 65 students many of which to the CANSail Two level. We identified and will be assisting in the development of four or five instructor candidates who will hopefully go on to be our first “Home Grown” youth instructors in a few years time.

Important to the membership, Youth Sail’s contribution to the profit of Yacht Club after all expenses and provisions etc was almost \$12,000, making it the largest bottom line contributor to the Club.

The Club has secured assistance from the Town for further contributions to the program of \$2,500 per year for four years.

2023

We will be running 6 weeks of camps. Four weeks for regular students and two weeks for advanced and older students.

In the past there has been some concern about the amount of work hours used during camps so for 2023 we will run the camp portion of the camps using volunteer hours not work hours.

It is anticipated we again will contribute about \$10,000 in profits directly to the bottom line of the Club.
