This Saturday's outboard motor class will focus on the following topics:

- How to recognize potential carburetor issues and tips for disassembly and inspection.
- When and how to replace lower gear oil and the impeller, including key points to watch for.

While most modern engines now use EFI (Electronic Fuel Injection) instead of carburetors, the lower unit remains the same.

We will cover these topics in a concise and hands-on session lasting around 2–3 hours, using actual parts and components for demonstration.
