

## **Bob and Lee Gurr Tweaking:**

### Eligibility:

1. Current Full Members in good standing only
2. The Award needs to recognize peers.
3. The project or initiative must have been initiated and completed **within the last two years**. See attached for Nomination.

Paul has been nominated but does not fit the current 'Eligibility' requirements.

### Criteria:

1. Must be sustainable, unique, even creative. Conceived and championed by the nominee.
2. Must be for something new and innovative that brings status, sustainability or recognition to the Club. The Club and its members must be better off following the execution of the project or initiative
3. Must be easily recognizable by a broad cross section of the membership
4. Should be awarded on merit and not necessarily every year.

### Process:

1. The current Commodore will head a three person Committee who will put a call out to the Membership for nominees in February.
2. A simple form outlining the Name of the person, the reason for the application and a description of why it meets the criteria should be included.
3. Three applications will be submitted to the Gurr's for their determination of the winner. In the event of more than three nominees the current Committee will vote on and select what they consider as the three best candidates. The award will be given on meritorious consideration and will not necessarily be awarded every year so that only truly worthy projects or initiatives are to be considered.

Award: The name and year awarded will be put on a plaque to be displayed in the clubhouse. The Award will be presented at an appropriate time agreeable with the winner and presenter. The recipient also receives a token monetary award of \$400.00
