WORK HOURS



It's the Final Countdown!!!

You have about 2 weeks left!



Your time to get your club work hours in is quickly drawing to a close (September 30th), however, don't despair. There is still work that can be completed!

This year we are holding our Commodore's Ball at our club on our beautiful grounds. We have some work we can complete before this event.

Some of the work could be completed any time, however, it may be more effective or beneficial to complete closer to the Commodore's Ball on October 4th. Check with Kevin if you are unsure.

A load of gravel is being delivered Monday Afternoon (September 15). The lot next to the pavilion needs more gravel. We need to move the angled paving markers (HEAVY) and spread the gravel before returning the markers. It would also be better to edge the grass between the lot and the grass by the pavilion for a neater seamless look. Depending upon how far the gravel goes, the low spot just inside the gate needs filling. Then, proceeding east, towards the back new lot, there are pot holes and low spots. The area along the wooden neighbour's fence could use more stone to bury all the weeds. Gravel could also be backfilled under the wheelchair ramp.





The Area by the Dumpster Needs Attention



We need to bag any yard waste and cut up and discard any wood or other refuse. We may need a small trailer to cart away any of the remaining dirt or ??????

Weeding should be done between the gate and white fence-and the general area including the front sign garden just outside the entrance.



Weeds continue to be an unsightly problem. If we could focus mostly on the prominent areas-front sidewalk entrance, front lot next to paving markers/grass, in front of the club on the west side, etc.

All gardens are at the point in the year when they could use a little help-mainly trimming dead parts or old flowers, etc.



Picnic Tables

They always need a cleaning - bird droppings, spider webs. However, beneath them is an area I would like to clean up. Weeds have returned in the cracks. Dead grass clipping lie beneath. I would love it if the grass around the paving stones could be edged to complete a neat and finished look.



A lot of work has been completed along the mast rack and on the outside hill.

There are a few more vines along the chain link that can be torn down. The area beneath the mast rack could be raked.







The weeds on the walkways keep coming back!! They could be pulled. (Editor's Note: According to the Dock Policy, Walkways are to be maintained in a neat and orderly manner. The assumption would be by the member who is using the dock.)



The area along the gyn pole at the front could



also use some cleaning up.

The weeds on the steel break wall have returned.

There are many ongoing cleaning chores that can be completed.

- Wipe down spider webs on: Deck, railing, clubhouse, deck furniture, chairs, pavilion, carriage lights (posts), Pavilion furniture.
- Clean (wet cloth) furniture and picnic tables.
- Windows could be cleaned before The Commodore's Ball
- The pavilion floor needs to be weeded.
- Club siding and 'breezeway' could be cleaned.
- Pick up twigs and sticks around the property.
- Leaf blow the wooden decks-including new deck.
- Clean new Muskoka chairs.
