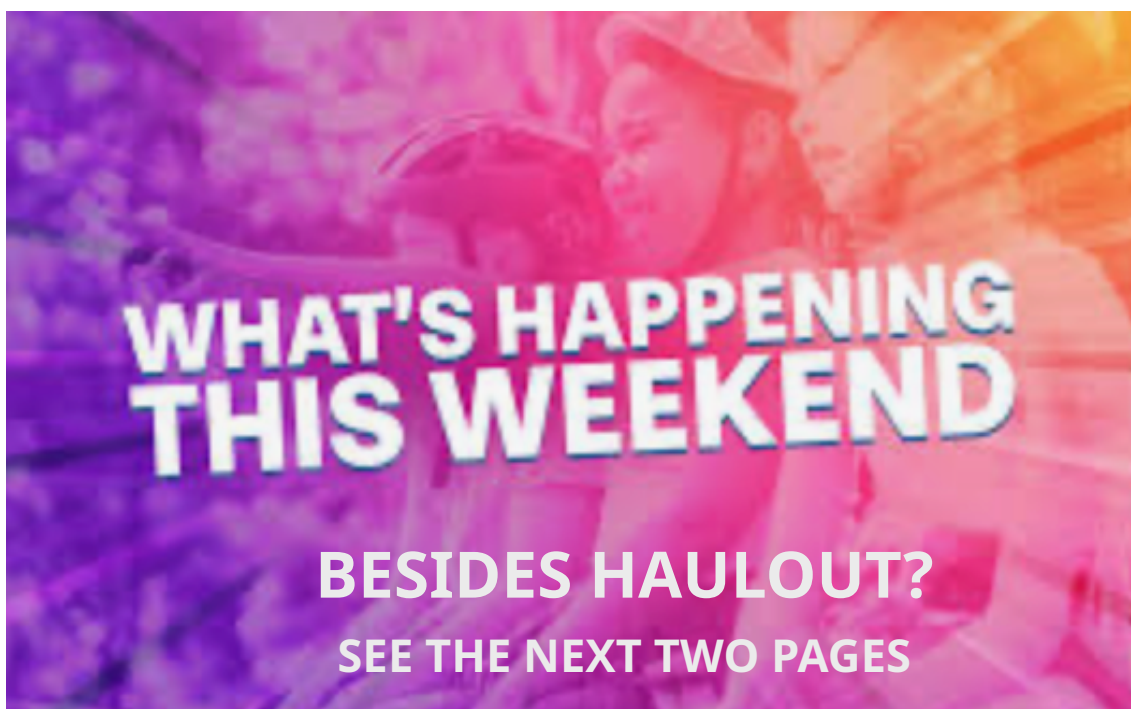

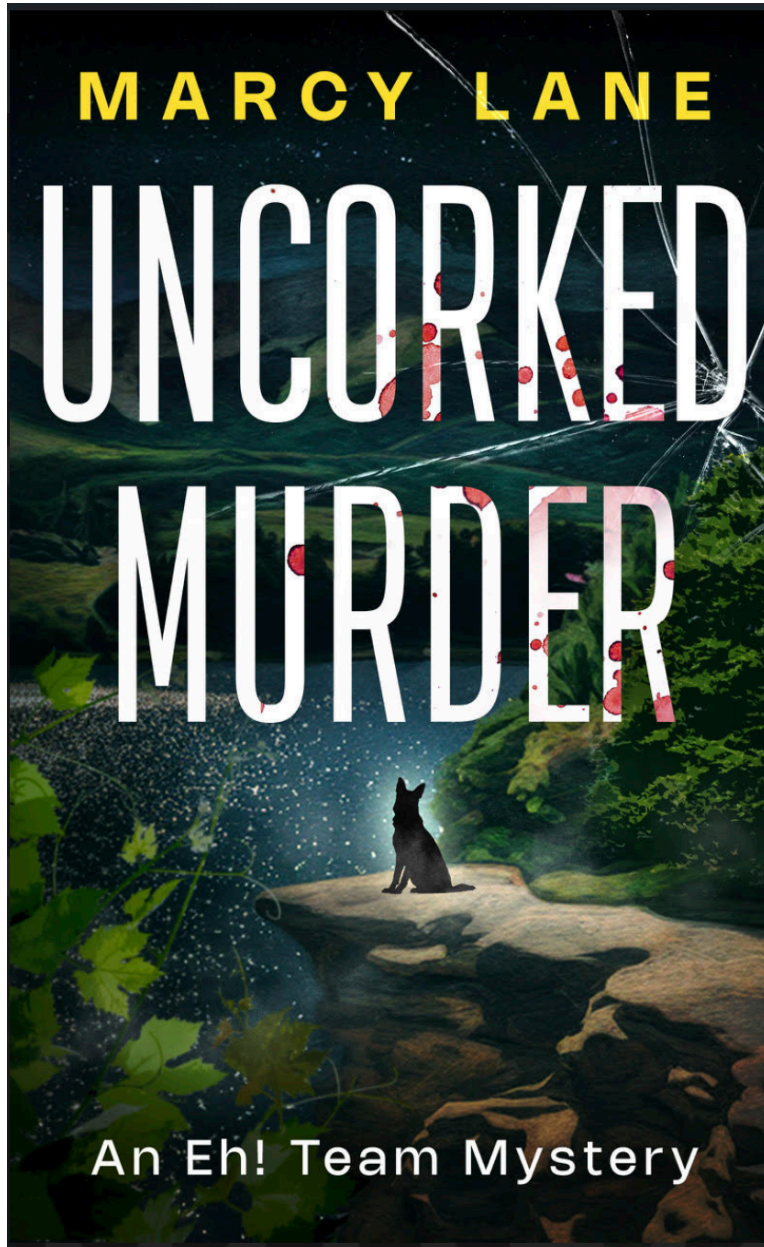

Uncorked Murder

An Eh! Team Mystery — Book One

In Erie Bluff, a lakeside town where gossip flows faster than the wine, the annual festival is meant to celebrate good harvests and better company—until a sharp-tongued critic drops dead just thirty minutes into the tasting.

Trixie Thorne had plenty of enemies, but when suspicion lands on George Fenn—a gentle, autistic mushroom expert with a public grudge—the town's top cop leaps to charge him. Piper Merriwether, a civilian analyst still new to town, knows her roommate isn't capable of murder. With the help of her sharp-eyed aunt and a quietly observant constable, she forms an unlikely alliance to uncover the truth.

They have just over a day to untangle decades-old grudges,

vineyard rivalries, and a poisoning that began long before the final toast—before George is remanded and lost to a system that won't protect him.

Set in a richly drawn town as tangled and tenacious as the vines that surround it, *Uncorked Murder* is a cozy-adjacent mystery about found family, quiet courage, and what justice really means in a place where everyone knows your name. Perfect for fans of Louise Penny, Richard Osman, and Ann Cleeves.
